

Italian Whites

Per Bottle

1. **PIENO SUD BIANCO (Sicily) £12.95**
Very smooth and well balanced, with rounded pear and apple flavours, dry and with sufficient flavour to accompany foods well. An excellent house wine made from Grecanico, Inzolia and Catarrato grapes.
2. **SOAVE CLASSICO DOC (11.5%) ½ bottle £9.50**
A balanced, medium-bodied dry white with subtle, fresh aromas and a restrained yet satisfying palate.
3. **TREBBIANO D'ABRUZZO DOC (11.5%) – Cantina Tollo £14.95**
Clean, fresh, grapy white has subtle hints of Almonds and Lemons
4. **FRASCATI SUPERIORE (12%) ½ bottle £8.95**
An excellent fruity white wine from the well-known “San Marco” region of central west Italy. Compliments both fish and pasta very well.
5. **FRASCATI SUPERIORE SATINATA D.O.C (12%) £16.50**
Candied fruit aromas with a hint of honey characterise this wine as a benchmark, the palate is round and soft with light buttery tones.
6. **PECORINO TERRE DI CHIETTI (11.5%) – Cantina Tollo £26.95**
An aromatic dry white wine made form the pecorino grape variety grown in Puglia region. A dry wine, full bodied with a distinct character.
7. **CASASOLE ORVIETO CLASSICO AMABILE £16.95**
Soft fruity and fragrant on the nose. Clean and fresh with a hint of sweetness on the finish
8. **PINOT GRIGIO TRENINO D.O.C (13%) – Le Meridiane £19.50**
Pale straw yellow, clear cut and delicate on nose with a scent of acacia flower, minerals and pears
9. **SANNIO FALANGHINA MASTROBERARDINO £27.95**
Light straw yellow with greenish reflections. Fresh and fruity, with strong and persistent notes of citrus fruit, pineapple and white flowers.
10. **GAVI DI GAVI D.O.C LA MEIRANA £28.95**
One of the true great Italian wines, this wine is delicate with appley undertones, clean fresh and has a wonderful finish.
11. **GRECO DI TUFO £34.95**
Aromatic, with white peach and orange blossom aromas. The palate is creamy at first, then crisp and citrusy on the finish
12. **NEMORINO BIANCO £24.95**
This excellent Tuscan wine blends Trebbiano and Semillon grape varieties. It is part-aged in wood for approximately 5 months, then in bottle.

Rest of the World Whites

13. **GRAN HACIENDA SAUVIGNON BLANC – Santa Rita (Chile) £17.50**
This pale yellow coloured wine is showing fresh, bright citrus and pear fruit flavours followed by smoke and a touch of herb.
14. **THE LONG PADDOCK CHARDONNAY – Redbank (Australia) £17.95**
The palate is vibrant with melon and stone fruit characters, medium bodied in weight with a cleansing acidity suitable for lightly flavoured meals.
15. **CHABLIS DOMAINE HAMELIN (France) £29.95**
Fine floral aromas and round powerful notes of white fruit and citrus with an elegant hint of minerality on the finish.
16. **SANCERRE “LES BAUDRIERES” DOMINIQUE BAUD (France) £30.95**
The most famous of all Loire Sauvignons, Sancerre is renowned for its crisp, citrus and gooseberry expressions.
17. **CHENIN BLANC (South Africa) £15.95**
Balanced and racy, with lemon, lime, lychee and honey on the nose. This is delicious with seafood, chicken, pasta or salads.
18. **PULIGNY MONTRACHET - Vieilles Vignes (France) £60.00**
Puligny Montrachet is the second of the great pair of Montrachet villages, offering the finest white wines known to man. The gently sloping vineyards face east and the soil is chalky clay with plenty of stones to ensure the land is well drained. The combination of these factors contributes to the production of truly outstanding Chardonnay, rich fruit with a mineral steeliness.
19. **TORRONTES – (Argentina) £15.50**
Floral, herbal, and quite flamboyant aromatics, with nice leafy fruit. The palate has a nicely sour edge of granny smith apples. It is tangy and lively, with crisp lemony notes. Very nice aperitif wine

Dessert Wine

20. **DINDARELLO - Maculan ½ bottle £16.95**
A little gem! Hand-made, world-class dessert wine made from sweet Muscat grapes in the passito style (semi-dried grape); the perfect compliment for most desserts.

Rosé Wine

21. **BARDOLINO CHIARETTO (12%) – Sartori £16.95**
This wine is dry and refreshing, showing exceptional cherry flavours
22. **PINOT GRIGIO BLUSH (12%) £17.95**
Salmon pink in colour with an aromatic nose. The palate is light, dry and crisp.
23. **NEBLINA MERLOT ROSE (13%) – [Chile] £16.50**
Neblina has an intense colour and is bursting with mouth watering red fruit characters. A Fresh, soft and fruity easy drinking wine.

Italian Reds

24. **PIENO SUD ROSSO (Sicily)** **£12.95**
Full of red berry flavours, a smooth and easy to drink house wine.
Produced from Syrah, Sangiovese and Nero d'Avola grapes
25. **CHIANTI CLASSICO – Di Cecchi** $\frac{1}{2}$ bottle **£12.95**
Medium bodied red, with intense fruit flavours. Highly recommended.
26. **MONTEPULCIANO D'ABRUZZO D.O.C (12%) – Cantina Tollo** **£15.50**
Medium bodied ruby red, with intense fruit flavours. Well balanced with a good structure.
27. **ANGELO NERO SANGIOVESE** **£14.95**
Lots of ripe young cherries on the nose, floral and perfumed. Soft, spicy fruit and silky tannins make this an exceptionally easy drinking wine.
28. **VALPOLICELLO VALPANTENA D.O.C (11.5%) - Cadoro** **£15.95**
Mid-garnet red, with an open, fruity nose and a fresh, bitter cherry character on the palate.
29. **MERLOT (12.5%) - Frattina** **£17.95**
Intense fruity aroma and typical Merlot grape flavour. Elegant and harmonious body.
30. **AGLIANICO DEL VULTURE D.O.C (13%) – D'Angelo** **£27.95**
This stands in the top rank of Italian Wines. Garnet with orange reflections, its bouquet is rich and smooth with a remarkable depth of flavour.
31. **CHIANTI CLASSICO (12.5%) –Di Cecchi** **£25.95**
Medium bodied ruby red, with intense fruit flavours. Well balanced with a good structure.
32. **PINOT NERO (13%) - Vallarom** **£31.95**
In Italy, where Pinot Noir is known as "Pinot Nero", it has traditionally been cultivated to produce Burgundy style red wines. This comes highly recommended.
33. **NEMORINO ROSSO** **£26.95**
Produced in Tuscany from a blend of Red Grapes Syrah 60%, Sangiovese 30% Merlot 10%. This wine undergoes aging in wood for several months, then in bottle.
34. **BELCORE** **£31.95**
A blend of Sangiovese and Merlot grape varieties gives this multi-award winning wine a full bodied flavour. This is a medium-bodied yet luscious wine. The palate bursts with attractive violet and blackberry flavours, followed by a long and substantial finish.

Rest of the World Reds

35. **CHATEAU MONTAIGUILLON**
Montagne-Saint-Emilion (Bordeaux) [France] ½ bottle £15.95
This has a delicious supple red fruit character of plums, blackcurrants and cherries backed up by good structure and ripe tannins. It will age well.
36. **CAMPO VIEJO RIOJA (13.5%) – Crianza [Spain] £21.95**
This wine has a deep cherry colour with some hints of cranberry and redcurrants, followed by a smooth, elegant finish.
37. **CABERNET SAUVIGNON RESERVA (13.5%) [Chile] £18.95**
A deeply coloured red wine, full bodied and fruity in the mouth with subtle notes of black fruit, plums and fine herbs gracefully combined with vanilla, cloves and fragrant spices. Good with meat.
38. **THE LONG PADDOCK SHIRAZ (REDBANK) [Australia] £19.50**
An approachable medium bodied wine with fine silky tannins. A generous palate of plum, cherry fruit and spice
39. **FLEURIE HENRI LA FONTAINE (13%) [France] £27.95**
This Fleurie shows the classic floral, rose and violet aromas associated with the variety.
40. **CHÂTEAUNEUF DU PAPE – [France] £35.95**
A blend of mainly Syrah and Grenache grapes gives this full-bodied wine it's rich and soft but powerful character.
41. **CLOOF PINOTAGE – [South African] £26.95**
The bold concentrated flavours of this wine are directly attributed to the tiny yield of mature bush vines growing under extreme conditions. Dark purple in colour, aromas of spice and banana with hints of candyfloss on the palate which is elegantly structured and displays a spiciness, warmth and softness.

Special Vintage

42. **BAROLO D.O.C. (13.5%) - ODDERO – [South African] £41.95**
The King of Wines – well aged, Oddero's Barolo already shows a developed, complex spicy nose and a multi-layered palate with a long, warm and tannic finish.
43. **BARBARESCO - [Single Vineyard] £44.95**
A powerful red made from the Nebbiolo grape in the Piedmont region. The typical style of a Barbaresco has bouquets of roses or violets with notes of cherry, truffles and fennel. As it ages it can develop more smokey notes and earthy flavours.
44. **BRUNELLO DI MONTALCINO D.O.C.G. - [Single Vineyard] £72.95**
This excellent vintage wine has a lively garnet colour with an intense odour of aromatic woods, small fruit, vanilla and fruity jams. This dry wine has an elegant and harmonic body with strength and breeding. Well aged and one of the best.
45. **TIGNANELLO ANTINORI - [Single Vineyard] £105.00**
Family owned and operated since 1385 this fine Tuscan wine is intensely fruity and complex on the nose, with hints of wood full-bodied, rich and complex in the mouth with exceptional structure and a lengthy finish.

Sparkling Wines

46. **ASTI SPUMANTE D.O.C (6%) – Vallebelbo** **£18.95**
Italy's famous sparkling wine noted for its seductive Moscato aroma, refreshing sweetness and moderate alcohol.
47. **PROSECCO DI VALDOBBIADENE BRUT D.O.C (11.5%)** **£23.95**
Lively and versatile, this straw coloured wine boasts a particularly fruity freshness. Light, crisp and gently effervescent, it is refreshing and easy to drink.

Champagne

48. **PAUL LANGIER BRUT (12.5%)** **£44.00**
Excellent Value House Champagne perfect for those special occasions.
49. **GRAN CUVEE BRUT D.O.C (12%) – Bellavista** **£60.00**
Intense, fresh and penetrating perfume with reflections of laurel and almonds, dry without excess, matured for 36 months.
[Methode Champenoise]
50. **GRAN CUVEE BRUT ROSE (12%) – Bellavista** **£66.00**
The grapes are vinified with brief skin contact. Matured for 36 months, coral rose in colour with copper undertones with fresh delicate perfume.
[Methode Champenoise]
51. **VEUVE CLICQUOT (12%)** **£68.00**
From one of the most prestigious Champagne houses, this brut is the gold standard for non-vintage Champagne. With a blend of two thirds Pinot Noir and Pinot Meunier grapes balanced with one third Chardonnay; it has a fine persistent sparkle and a rich and nutty taste with a long lingering finish. Simply Superb!
52. **MOET AND CHANDON (12%)** **£58.00**
A harmonious blend of the Pinot and Chardonnay varieties, it is pale yellow in colour with shades of green. The aroma is deliciously vinuous with lime undertones. An excellent champagne for those special occasions.
